

## Request for a "Statement of Compliance" (Italy)

Owners of a Zenair design registered in Italy who wish to receive a statement from Zenair indicating that their aircraft complies with the AERO CLUB D'ITALIA's definition of an ultralight may request such a statement by completing the request below.

Please note that such a statement can only be granted on a case-by-case basis, and only for aircraft that have been built – and are maintained – in compliance with Zenair's technical drawings, assembly manuals and maintenance instructions for type. Any modification which alters the structure or performances of the aircraft will render a Statement of Compliance VOID. Zenair (or a duly appointed representative) reserves the right to inspect any Zenair for which a Certificate of Compliance has been issued; said certificate may be revoked if the aircraft is found to be out of compliance.

A first Statement of Compliance will be granted free of charge for a particular aircraft; there will be a charge for all subsequent Statements for the same aircraft. Please complete all sections below and answer all questions, then return this completed 2-page form by mail with your payment of 50.00 € to: Zenair Europe, ZI No. 2 Aerodrome de Valenciennes 59121 PROUVY.
